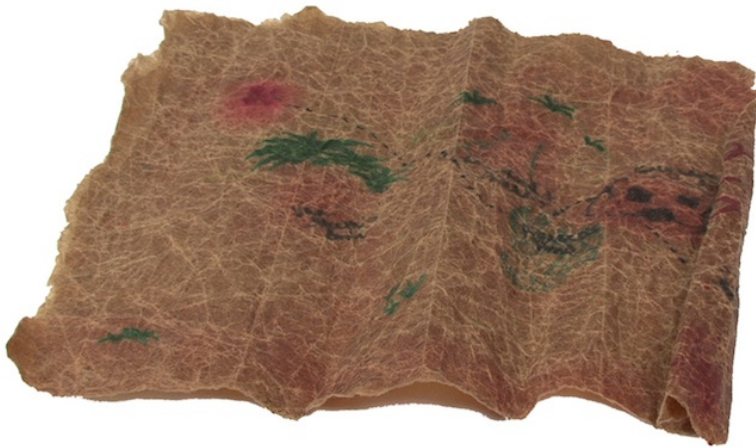


Pirate Map

Arrggg, Mateys! Bury some treasure, then create your very own pirate map.



Materials

Brown Paper Bag
Markers
Vegetable Oil
Paper Towels

Directions

1. Rip the paper until you have a flat piece of “parchment.”
Note: Ripping works better than scissors, although you can cut the bag first, then rip the edges.
2. Using markers, draw a picture of a map
3. Crumple up the bag into a tight ball then open it up.
4. Place a small amount of vegetable oil on a paper towel and rub it over the map.
5. Allow to dry in the sun (approx. 2 hour)

Tips:

- Start with a small amount of vegetable oil. You can always add more.
- Washable markers (and even sharpies) might run or bleed a little. That’s okay! It makes the map look old and worn, but be careful about clothing and workspaces.
- The map might feel greasy at first. It will dry into a parchment like texture.
